



EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Journalism's main objective is to inform the public about pressing topics and current happenings. For students, journalism serves as a means of acquiring the knowledge and skills necessary to function as informed, involved citizens to contribute to public discourse, and develop the ability to make thoughtful decisions about timely and relevant subjects.

The study aimed to develop a web-based journalism platform for The Bastion Group of Publications where writers can create articles and collaborate with other TBGP writers and for President Ramon Magsaysay State University students to read into.

The system conformed to all performance-based requirements that served as a common framework for the production of specific operational requirements. The system has functional requirements such as Account registration, validation, and authentication, posiiio application, creating a story request write-up creation and publication while its Non-Functional Requirements are based on the ISO/IEC 25010:2011 Metrics.

The TBGP writers and students evaluated the system quality and the level of acceptability of the E-Write: A Web Based Journalism Platform for The Bastion Group of Publications using the ISO/EC 25010:2011 metric with a total of 140 respondents. Based on the overall results, the respondents evaluated the system's quality as "Excellent" with a grand mean of 3.49 and the level of acceptability as "Accepted" with a grand mean of 3.10.

The study outcome provided valuable recommendations that concentrates on fulfilling user requirements, ensuring accurate data and authentication that serves the system's purpose, leading to the final recommendation of implementation of the system.
